


What is IF THIS HOUSE COULD TALK?



IF THIS HOUSE COULD TALK is a community-based history project, first created and displayed by residents of Cambridgeport, MA. Due to its popularity, similar projects with the same name happen annually in places like Sacramento, CA, Newburyport, MA, Mesquite, NV and Calgary, Alberta.

Local history is presented by residents and businesses posting handmade signs in front of their homes and buildings which tell stories and offer information from the past. Information can range from the history of a building or a neighborhood to personal stories of past residents of a particular house. The storyboards are on display for people to read and learn from as they stroll or drive through the community.

Please do remember that private homes and gardens are **NOT** open to the public. You are invited to read the storyboards posted in front of houses, but the privacy of homeowners should otherwise be respected. Thank you – and have fun!


